# Thank you for taking part and providing feedback on our proposals for a new reservoir in the Fens.

#### Our proposed location for the reservoir is between Chatteris and March.

Our site selection process assessed the most suitable sites and this location was found to be the most appropriate for building a new reservoir, and, on balance, performed best across a range of the key factors we assessed. It also provides opportunities to deliver wider benefits to the regional economy and neighbouring communities. The map, as shown on page 15 of the consultation brochure, shows a pink area for the reservoir and its embankments.

We've also identified an initial wider area of land we could need for supporting infrastructure and during construction (grey area on the consultation maps). This is also where we could include wildlife and environmental areas, spaces for leisure and recreation, education facilities and others. These are the additional developments that would help ensure the reservoir brings social and environmental benefits, alongside water supply. This area is only indicative at this stage and is subject to change following consultation, and as we develop our proposals.
